

THE PROJECT

The TechTex project aims to improve vocational education in Morocco, focusing on Textile Engineering and Textile Technology studies. It will modernize curricula and enhance the skills of trainers and students through innovative methods and best practices. To bridge the gap between current VET offerings and industry needs, TechTex will create a MOOC with a flipped classroom approach and a train-the-trainer program to replicate best practices across Morocco.



THE PARTNERSHIP

The created partnership brings together 8 institutions with complementary profiles and competencies, including VETs, training centers and industry related profiles. Partners belong to four EU Member States, i.e Turkey, Spain, Greece, and Italy and one third country, Morocco.

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TRANSNATIONAL MEETINGS

The project **kick-off meeting** took place in Izmir, Turkey in January 2024 and was hosted by Ege University. During the meeting the team aligned on goals and objectives, defined roles and agreed on a work plan.

The **second transnational meeting** was organised by OFFPT in Rabat and Casablanca, Morocco, on 27 and 28 June 2024. The meeting was an important moment to discuss the first project results, to monitor the project implementation and to define the next steps.

The Moroccan partners have carried out extensive research to identify the gaps between the current provision in Moroccan vocational training centres and the needs of industry, with the aim of producing truly effective materials.

The desk research, qualitative research and training needs baseline study identify relevant topics, priorities and skills needed for short- and medium-term programme updates in vocational training centres.
